** The Department of Genetics allows GENE 4960R, GENE 4970R or GENE 4980R for only 3 or 4 credit hours. A minimum of 3 hours of work in the lab per week is required for each credit hour requested. Students who complete the sequence of 4960R, 4970R and 4980R under the supervision of the same faculty sponsor satisfy the Genetics major lab requirement. Completing a 4960R does not obligate the faculty member to continue supervising research for additional semesters or sponsoring a thesis. You should discuss with your faculty mentor expectations for continuing research. A single 4960R can count as a major elective but will not count towards the lab requirement.*

Faculty sponsors of undergraduate research must complete an assessment of the student's written report using the rubric and send that assessment to Dr. Mauricio and Mr. Norman. Faculty who agree to continue sponsoring research beyond a 4960R should expect that students will be allowed to complete the research sequence of GENE 4970R and 4980R.
